

Motions Passed

- Young Fine Gael calls on the Government to honour the legacy of former Taoiseach Dr. Garret FitzGerald by renaming Dublin Airport as 'Garret FitzGerald Airport'. *Proposed by the National Executive*
- This motion session calls on the YFG National Executive to campaign for, at the next available opportunity, an amendment be made to the Fine Gael Constitution and Rules Article 53 (iv). The effect of this amendment shall be to reduce the number of Parliamentary Party nominations required to contest the Presidential Selection process, in line with that imposed by Article 49 (i) (e) [10% of PP] for the election of a Party Leader. *Proposed by Wexford (with similar motion from the Leinster Regional Council)*
- This motion session calls on the YFG National Executive to campaign for, at the next available opportunity, amendments to the Fine Gael Constitution and Rules [Articles 53 (i) & 53 (iv)] to ensure greater fairness and accessibility in the selection of both the Presidential election candidate and the Party Leader. *Proposed by Wexford (with similar motion from Leinster Regional Council)*
- Young Fine Gael calls on the Government to implement measures to significantly increase the pace of infrastructure delivery, including measures to support streamlined and faster planning approval processes for major infrastructural projects, and additional resourcing of the High Court's Planning and Environmental Divisions to deliver more efficient verdicts. *Proposed by Waterford (with similar motion from Kerry)*
- Young Fine Gael calls on the Government to convene a Citizens' Assembly on the Future of Local Government, with a particular emphasis on the direct election of strong and accountable mayors across all local authorities, following the Limerick model. *Proposed by Kerry*
- Iarann Ógra Fhine Gaeil ar an rialtas a pleananna a chur i bhfeidhm chun a chinntiú go mbuaidh ar an laghad Gaelcholáiste amháin i ngach contae roimh deireadh 2030. *Proposed by Cóiste na Gaeilge*
- YFG calls for increased investment in women's health targeted at young women, including free contraception and period products in schools and colleges, and youth-friendly clinics offering inclusive reproductive care and support. *Proposed by Women's Network*
- YFG calls on Fine Gael to push for a suspension of any further MERCOSUR negotiations subject to an investigation into South American countries compliance with animal husbandry and public health regulations. *Proposed by Clare (with similar motion from Agricultural & Rural Affairs Forum)*
- YFG calls on the government to enforce every person who lives in the Pale to watch Clarkson's Farm. *Proposed by UCC (with similar motion from Kerry & Cork South Central)*
